INTRODUCTION

Welcome! Explorers is our well-loved after school program for children from PreK 4-5th grade, and is housed at Hexter, Reilly & Sanger Elementary Schools. Our program runs from 3:15 pm – 5:55 pm*, Monday-Friday, and we follow the DISD calendar.

Explorers is under the Studio Bella for Kids Enrichment umbrella. The STEAM-based program is filled with STEAM-based projects/activities, sportsmanship/ teambuilding and games that focus on skills and strategy. Fridays rotate between Building Bonanza, A fun Philanthropy Project, Perler Beads, and SEL. Established here in East Dallas in 2009, Studio Bella for Kids began with a mom of two boys who wanted to pair fun and



learning together to begin a great summer program. Fast forward to today, you will find that Studio Bella is immersed and vested in East Dallas and Dallas children year-round. We would LOVE to have you join us at Explorers! *If DISD changes the beginning/ending time of school, we will adjust accordingly.

REGISTRATION

Beginning May 15, you can reserve your child's spot in our Explorers program. At that time, you will enter some basic information about your child/children, enter payment information, and be charged the reservation fee. Our reservation fee is \$150 per child and is non-refundable. Your funds are used during the summer months to order supplies for STEAM projects, curriculum, coordination, and required staff training. Tuition is autodrafted (\$235) on the first of every month beginning August 1st. We anticipate a waitlist at all three of our schools, so we recommend registering early.

Registration works best on a desktop computer and takes about 15 minutes to complete. During registration, you will be asked to provide additional information requested by Studio Bella and Childcare Licensing, so that we can serve your child to the best of our ability).

Fine print: Registration closes on July 31st and spaces are limited. If we have the ability to serve more students (there is no guarantee due to licensng requirements), registration will reopen September 1. Space availability is based on the child/caregiver ratio set by Texas Health & Human Services & licensing capacity.

In the lives of children, SEL is part of daily learning each and every day as they grow and mature. Social Emotional Learning helps children within these 5 key areas:

- 1. Self Awareness and Confidence
- 2. Self-Management and Regulation
- 3. Social Awareness/Compassion for Others
- 4. Relationship Skills
- 5. Responsible Decision Making

Check out our monthly focus. We truly have seen the impact of SEL within our Explorers Program.

RATIOS & AGES & GROUPINGS

During Explorers, the children are grouped by grade levels. Depending on the number of children, grade levels close in age may be grouped together. Our child to caregiver ratio is 1:10 to 1:15 within our prek/k groups at all times and during STEAM time for the older groups. During non-STEAM times, 1st grade-5th grade, our goal is a 1:20 ratio. The state guideline has a maximum of 26 in a group.



EXPLORERS REGISTRATION FEE AND TUITION

Description	Amount	Due Date	Notes
Registration fee	\$150	Upon registration.	This is a one-time fee that covers training, supplies and planning.
Monthly Tuition	\$235	Auto drafted at the first of every month.	Payments are due in full on the first. We do not split payments between parties.

CANCELLATIONS/LATE PICKUP

AFTERCARE CANCELLATION AND REFUND POLICY

If your child is not going to attend Explorers for the last month of school, we require a written notice no later than March 31st. If you cancel your Explorers account during the months of August – April, there is a \$25.00 administration fee. Also, if you cancel your account and decide to re-enroll, you will need to register your child again which includes having the registration fee auto-drafted. There are no refunds on the dates that are not used if you cancel mid-month.



Refunds are forfeited if children are no longer able to participate due to behavioral problems, suspension, or expulsion.

Note - Cancellation due to long periods of illness, or extreme family hardships will be reviewed on a case-by-case basis.

LATE PICKUP:

(Beginning at 6:01, a \$25.00 late fee invoice will be autodrafted from your account).

- Pick up time is documented when the child/children are physically released to the parent(s).
- The cell phone of the Studio Bella employee in charge of dismissal will be used to determine the time of pickup.

OUR TEAM TRAINING

Our educators/group leaders are carefully selected and screened. Our team is required to complete 15 hours of training annually in child development, safety, and risk, SEL, STEAM, Pediatric First Aid, C.P.R., & curriculum delivery. Criminal background checks, FBI fingerprint background checks, and character reference checks are required.

FAQs

Q: Does the Explorers Program fill up before school begins?

A: Yes! Some schools fill up by mid summer. We anticipate each school to be full with a wait list for the 2024-25 school year.

Q: Is the same amount due every month? I see that some months Explorers attend more days in come months compared to other months?

A: Yes. Tuition amounts are the same each month and are due on the 1st. We total the number of days in the program, multiply by the daily rate and divide by 10 to get the monthy tuition.

Q: We are divorced. Can the tuition be split between two people or can we alternate payments?

A: Our platform does not allow payments to be split. Parents wanting to alternate payments each month would need to change the payment method in their account each month.

Q: Does Studio Bella accept ACH?

A: Studio Bella no longer accepts ACH payments.

Q: Does Studio Bella offer a multichild discount?

A: We are unable to offer a multichild discount at this time.
